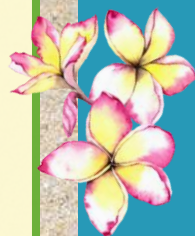

Cocktail of the Month

Mango Margarita

Kosher salt for rim of glass
1 and 1/2 ounces mango flavored tequila
1/2 ounce high quality orange liqueur
4 ounces mango puree
4-6 ounces sour mix
lime to garnish



1. Salt the rim of the glass, if desired
2. Fill a metal cocktail shaker with a large scoop of ice. Add the mango tequila, orange liqueur, mango puree, and sour mix. Shake vigorously.
3. Pour the margarita into the glass. Garnish lime wedge.

Corpus Christi Resource Center: The Recovery Resource Center is an effort to aid clients who are suffering from drug addiction and other forms of chemical dependencies.

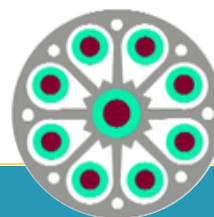
