HURRICANE

Combine 1/4 cup (about 2½ oz.) dark rum, 1½ Tbsp. passionfruit syrup, and 1½ Tbsp. fresh lemon juice in an ice-filled cocktail shaker. Cover with lid, and shake vigorously until chilled. Pour into a hurricane glass filled with crushed ice. Top with ½ Tbsp. overproof rum, and garnish with a lime slice and a maraschino cherry, if desired.
