



PINA COLADA COOKIES

Ingredients

1 1/4 cup all purpose flour

3/4 cup granulated sugar

1/4 cup packed brown sugar

1/2 tsp baking soda

1/4 tsp salt

1/2 tsp vanilla extract

1/2 tsp coconut extract

½ cup butter

1 large egg

1 ½ cups sweetened shredded coconut

2 tbsp butter

½ cup finely diced dried pineapple



Preparation

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

In one bowl, combine flour, salt, and baking soda.

In a larger bowl, cream the butter, sugar, and brown sugar together. Add in the vanilla and coconut extracts. Add one large egg. Begin mixing in the flour mixture slowly. Add the pineapple and coconut. Work the dough by hand until smooth.

Form the dough into 1 Tbsp balls and place on a nonstick cookie sheet. Bake for 9-11 minutes. Allow to cool on a rack.

Yields about 2 dozen cookies.


